




Key Points


- Net earnings: \$292 per cow in 2023, down from \$945 per cow in 2022
- Total costs increased, while milk prices declined
- This year's sample was 283 farms, including 143 from PA
- Cash flow was insufficient, on average, to meet all financial commitments, resulting in a cash margin of \$(0.40)/cwt
- Total liabilities per cow rose to \$5,976
- 2023 Milk price: \$22.76, \$3.90 below 2022
- NCOP: \$22.64, \$0.23 below 2022




Farm Milk Prices per Cwt.




Farm Milk Prices per Cwt.






Cash Flow Analysis per Cwt.

Key Points

- Profitability declined, as milk prices fell, while input costs remained elevated.
- Cash flow, including debt service, shifted negative.
- 2023 Milk price: \$22.76, \$3.90 below 2022
- NCOP: \$22.64, \$0.23 below 2022
- Positive correlations between farm size and profitability, but:
- Wide range of financial results among farms
- Differences seen between PA farms and NY/NE farms (at least in our sample)
